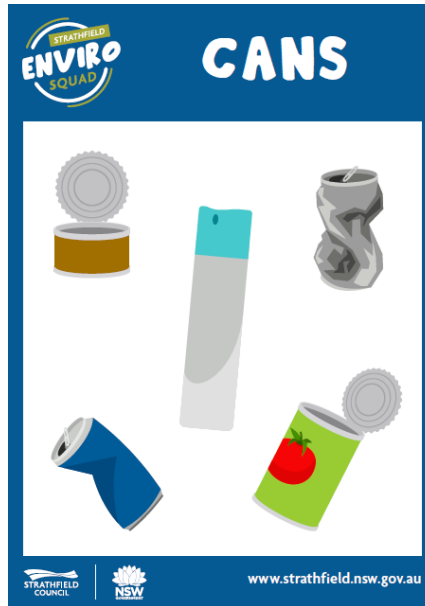
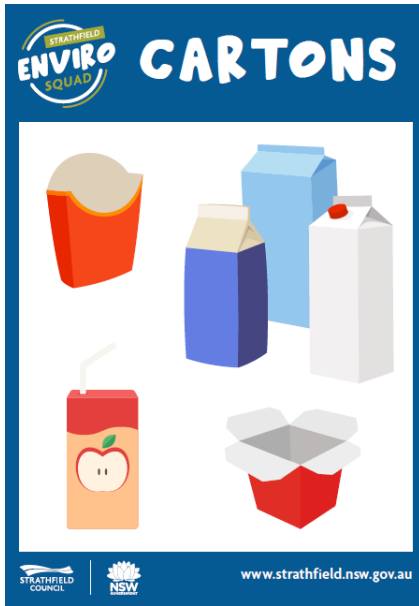

WHAT YOU NEED

1 Deck
2 - 4 Teams
or
2 - 4 Players
3 - 8 Targets
(Boxes)

FLICKER

THE DEAL:

Divide the players in 2 – 4 teams in case you are playing as a group. Shuffle the Item cards and divide them between the players/teams. As a group they have to divide the Item cards between their players. For the Targets, put 3 - 8 boxes (depending of the level) next to each other with the Waste Disposal card displayed in front of the box. All players/teams need their own boxes.

THE PLAY:

The players/teams have to stay at certain distance from the target and try to flicker the Item cards in the correct Disposal box in the least amount of time possible. If the Item card falls out of the target, one of the players has to get it and try again. As soon as the first player/team finishes, they have to say Stop! making the other players/teams stop as well. The player/team that gets more Item cards within correct Disposal boxes wins.

2 Decks
2 - 8 Teams
or
2 - 8 Players

BINGO

THE DEAL:

From the first deck of Item cards, shuffle the cards and distribute the same amount to each player/team. There will be players/teams and one "Caller" who will call out the Item cards that players/teams must match in order to complete their "Bingo" hand. Give to each player/team a pack of Waste Disposal cards.

THE PLAY:

From the second deck of cards, the "Caller" will select a card, one at a time, showing and calling out its name - for example "Glue Container - Hard Plastic". The player/team that has the called card will then put it on top of the correct Waste Disposal card. The first player/team to finish their cards have to say Bingo! If their cards are in the correct disposal, the player/team wins. If there are any mistakes, they are out of that round and the "Caller" will keep calling the cards.

1 Deck
2 - 4 Teams
or
2 - 4 Players

STOP

THE DEAL:

Divide the players in 2 – 4 teams in case you are playing as a group. Shuffle the Item cards and divide between the players/teams, giving to each a pack of 3 - 8 Waste Disposals cards as well (depending of the level).

THE PLAY:

As soon as the game starts, each player/team needs to put the Item cards on top of the correct disposal card in the least amount of time possible. In case they are working as a group it is recommended that they divide the Item cards between their players! As soon as the first player/team finishes, they have to say Stop! making the other players/teams stop at the same time.

The player/team that gets more correct Item cards wins.
