

ROAD & PATH CONDITION INSPECTION



WHAT WE'RE DOING...

We are undertaking an assessment of the municipalities 108km road network and 200km of footpaths and shared access ways. Inspection work will begin in August and take approximately two weeks to complete.

How's this happening:

- These activities are undertaken by council's asset inspection contractor, Infrastructure Management Group, as an asset management initiative to obtain detailed video imaging and condition assessment of the community's road, kerb & footpath assets.
- You may observe camera equipped, transporter style inspection vehicles traveling on local roads and quad bike style inspection vehicles on public footways around your work, residences or other locations within the municipality during this period.
- Road assessment vehicles are driven by experienced operators travelling at normal traffic speeds. Hazard lighting & other warning devices will be in operation while completing laser measurement and video recording activities of roads and access ways. They will operate seamlessly within the normal surrounding traffic patterns.
- Footpath assessment vehicles are operated by certified pavement inspectors travelling at a brisk walking pace. Hazard lighting & other warning devices will be in operation while completing assessment and video recording activities of footpaths, cycle ways and shared access ways. They are clearly identifiable and operators will be vigilant and yield where ever possible to the needs of the pedestrian public.

All cameras are focused on the road or footpath structure with some limited viewing of areas directly adjacent. No image recordings of commercial, residential, private properties or structures will be undertaken.
