## NOTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CHANGES AROUND TODMAN RESERVE

As per item 6.4 of the April 2023 Local Traffic Committee meeting, 'Todman Place, Strathfield – Amended Traffic Management Changes' and as resolved by Council, Council will be implementing sign and line marking and physical changes around Todman Reserve to better facilitate traffic movement and efficiency.




Figure 1 – existing signs and line marking around Todman Reserve

As shown in Figure 1, currently:

- Vehicles are allowed to stop but not park on the east side of Todman Reserve,
- There is a bus stop on the west side of Todman Reserve where the 483 and Strathfield Connector red and blue route buses stops to pick up and drop off passengers,
- There is unrestricted parking along the south side of Todman Reserve and on the south side of Barker Road with exception of the bus stop outside 22 Barker Road and the statutory 'No Stopping' within 10m of an unsignalized intersection,
- There is some non-signposted statutory 'No Stopping', and
- There is currently 1 southbound lane on Oxford Road to cater for both left- and right-turns onto Barker Road.




Figure 2 – final signs, line marking, and kerb buildout around Todman Reserve

In line with the Local Traffic Committee item, the following changes will be made around Todman Reserve as shown in Figure 2:

- Permanent 'No Stopping' will be implemented around all sides of Todman Reserve. This includes the removal of the bus stop, where the relocation of the bus stops are as follows:
  - 483 route from Strathfield to Central Pitt Street via Strathfield South: the existing upstream stop in front of 56 Oxford Road or the existing downstream stop in front of 44 Barker Road,
  - Strathfield Connector: the existing stop in front of 8 Wallis Avenue for the red route and the
    existing bus stop for the 407 bus route in front of 9 Barker Road for the blue route,
- The statutory 'No Stopping on the east side of Todman Reserve at Barker Road will be formalised by way
  of signs,

- 'No Stopping' from 8-9:30AM and 2:30-4PM during school days will be implemented along the south side of Barker Road to allow vehicles to pass those waiting to turn into Oxford Road. Furthermore, the existing 'Bus Zone' outside 22 Barker Road will be formalised by way of signs,
- The line marking on Oxford Road at Barker Road will be adjusted to provide separated left-and right-turn lanes onto Barker Road,
- The centre line marking on Oxford Road will be adjusted to provide sufficient width for kerbside parking and through traffic on the east side of the road,
- A 'Stop' priority at the north end of Todman Place will be implemented as this meets the warrants of reduced sight distance to the east along Oxford Road, and
- A minor kerb buildout on the south side of Oxford Road at Todman Place will be constructed to lower the speeds of vehicles turning left from Oxford Road into Todman Place.
