

Open Access Information

Not Publicly Available Government Information (Public) Access Act 2009

In accordance with Section 6 (5) of the *Government Information (Public) Access Act 2009 (GIPA Act)*, Strathfield Council must keep a record of any open access information that it does not make publicly available on the basis that there is an overriding public interest against disclosure.

The following table details open access information not disclosed due to an overriding public interest against disclosure:
