





CONSTRAINTS

Site is vulnerable to undesirable behaviour due to:

- Limited passive surveillance
- Single path of travel. i.e One entrance and one exit
- No commercial or active frontage onto the laneway





RESPONSE

 Formal design promotes territorial reinforcement

• No tables - can encourage undesirable behaviour at night in vulnerable locations. Pedestrian lighting

 Retain sight lines through site with low vegetation or high canopies



• Destination for nearby residents to go for a walk


 Desination for local families with children for outdoor activities, ride scooters, play on grass etc.
