RECOMMENDATION

That Council makes application for funding under the WestInvest Contested Grants Program for the following five projects: Intergenerational Hub (Bates Street) Children's Hub (Fraser Street), High Street Community Centre Extension, Upgrade of Cooke Park Skate Park and Revitalisation of Begnall Field.

PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council approval to submit applications for funding of the five projects under the WestInvest Contested Grants Program.

REPORT

Grant funding has been made available through the Department of Premier and Cabinet for infrastructure projects in 15 Local Government areas. The grants are open to Councils, NGO's, Community Groups and various other bodies on a contested basis under the WestInvest grants program.

The deadline for registrations of interest was the 21st April 2022, which was extremely tight. Council submitted registrations for five projects, details of which were provided to Councillors in a presentation at the Briefing Workshop on 26th April 2022.

The Registrations of Interest are currently being assessed by the Department to ensure they meet the strict eligibility requirements. Council will be advised in due course whether each proposed project has met the requirements or been rejected. Projects which have met the eligibility criteria will then be permitted to proceed to the detailed application stage.

At this stage Council is not aware of the result of the Departments assessment of each of its projects. Therefore this report is to obtain Council approval to submit detailed applications for funding on all projects approved by the Department to proceed to the application stage.
