This month
I hosted the
first ever
Mayoral Schools
Traffic and
Safety Forum.
Representatives
from 15 local
educational
institutions

attended the Forum and we had very productive discussions about improvements to traffic and safety around our schools.

One of the goals of the Forum is to improve bottle-necks at pick up and drop off times. We discussed a number of options which will go to a future traffic committee meeting for approval. Although this is a huge task, I am confident that, with time, our traffic team will be able to solve the local issues and lobby the State Government for any required assistance.

At the November Council Meeting, Council supported the submission of four projects to the NSW Government's West Invest

Grant Program. If Council is successful, the program will see a guaranteed \$21.8 million to local projects for Strathfield LGA. The projects we have sought funding for are a masterplan and completion of the Hudson Park Precinct at Homebush West; drainage and beautification upgrades at Airey Park, Homebush; drainage and building works at Begnell Oval, Belfield; and the completion of Strathfield Park including a storage shed and increased greenspace and planting.

We are hoping for an announcement regarding the success of the application very soon. Appropriate planning and consultation with residents and park users will be an important feature of the projects, to ensure the needs of all users and neighbours of these beautiful parks are considered.




#### **REDcycle**

#### Lets Stop it and Swap it

Did you know that 60% of litter in NSW is plastic packaging and single use items? The next wave of banned plastic came into effect on 1 November. Businesses and community organisations must stop supplying single-use plastic straws, stirrers, cutlery, bowls and plates as well as expanded polystyrene food service items like containers and cups, single-use plastic cotton buds, and some personal care products containing plastic microbeads.

#### **Hudson District Park Updates**
