After an extensive review involving community consultation, Council has decided to cease operation of the blue and red routes as part of the Strathfield Connector bus service on **Monday 4 March 2024**.

The Strathfield Connector bus service will now only operate along one route from Strathfield Station to Courallie Avenue on Monday to Friday from 7am to 7pm. This amended service will be in place for 2 years whilst Council lobbies the State Government to fill in transport gaps within the Strathfield LGA.

Beat the Heat

It's important to stay cool and hydrated during heatwaves to prevent heat-related illnesses. Here are a few ways to do this:

- **Recognise the Signs:** the signs of heat-related illnesses such as heat exhaustion and heatstroke may include heavy sweating, weakness, nausea, confusion, and even unconsciousness. If you or someone you know experiences these symptoms, seek medical help immediately.
- **Prepare Yourself and Your Home:** stay cool by wearing lightweight, light-coloured clothing and using fans or air conditioning when available. Limit outdoor activities during peak heat and take cool showers to reduce body temperature.
- **Plan Ahead:** prepare for heatwaves by having an emergency kit with water, non-perishable food, and essential supplies.

Let's stay cool and safe during the summer heatwaves to enjoy the season without health risks.



Footpath Upgrades

Council completed 8 footpath projects throughout December 2023 at Davidson St and Drew St in Greenacre, Dean St, River St and Hope St in Strathfield South and Homebush Rd, Mintaro Ave and Oxford Rd in Strathfield.

Over the coming weeks, footpaths along Ford St in Greenacre, Hampstead Road in Homebush West and High St in Strathfield will be upgraded in addition to roadworks taking place at Redmyre Rd, Noble Ave, Ada Ave, Wallis Ave and Macarthur Ave in Strathfield, Excelsior St in Belfield and Wentworth St in Greenacre.

Keep your eyes peeled as Council works towards renewing 4km of roads and 20km of footpaths in the Strathfield local government area.
