Marta and Karl have created a series of works that explores the interconnections of the near and far. This new exhibition will feature artworks that focus on repetitive motifs, abstract impressions, rhythmic metamorphosis, and an alchemic process. It offers an immersive and nomadic display by combining tapestries and works on paper with a mix of spinning, weaving, stitching, natural dying, painting, installation, and live-art.

Join artists Marta and Karl as they officially open the new exhibition at the Ironbark Gallery on Thursday 11 May 2023. In parallel to the exhibition, there will also be workshops on Monday 19 June and Thursday 22 June, where you can hear from both artists in a live discussion as they share aspects of their work, story, and practice.

The exhibition runs from 11 May to 25 June 2023 at the Ironbark Gallery located within the Strathfield Council Library & Innovation Hub, 65 – 67 Rochester Street, Homebush.
